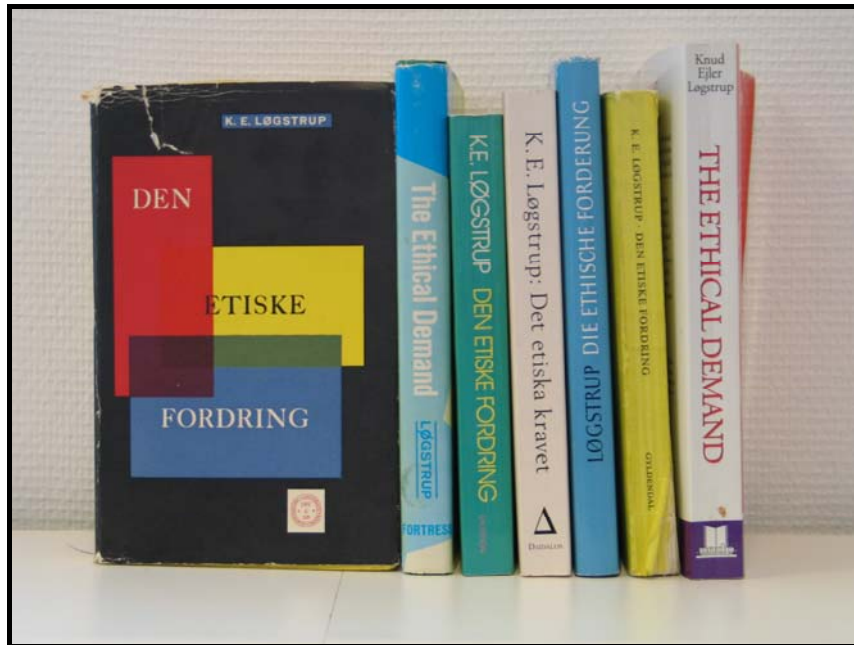

On 27 November 2006 it is precisely 50 years ago that K. E. Løgstrup's landmark book *The Ethical Demand* appeared. To celebrate this anniversary the Løgstrup Archive at the University of Aarhus has invited three prominent professors to give an estimate of the topicality of that book. In the morning, in his anniversary lecture, sociologist Zygmunt Bauman will discuss how hospitable the present world is to the ethical demand.
